While in recent years issues like combating climate change and fighting global pandemics have been in the forefront of the UN's efforts, the issue of International Peace and Security has never been out of sight and came to the limelight again on February 24th 2022. While Germany celebrated its 50th anniversary of joining the UN and decades of Peace and Prosperity surrounded by our neighbors and friends within Europe, a few hundred kilometers to the East millions of Europeans were forced to flee or hide in bunkers from an unprovoked aggression by their neighbor. The UN – as they were so often before – were criticized for "not doing enough" and the issue of Reform of the Security Council (UNSC) gained new momentum. How did and do the UN and its members states try to maintain/establish Peace? Which different perspectives and approaches exist to tackling the issues? Can and should the UNSC be reformed?

Important organizational notes:
